

Kerbside refuse collections in Somerset

Fortnightly Refuse Collections

Domestic refuse is collected fortnightly.

A wheeled bin is provided, if you have space to store it. Only refuse inside the bin will be collected; the lid should be closed.

Additional refuse alongside or on top of the bin will not be taken. If your property is unsuitable for a wheeled bin, up to four black sacks of refuse will be taken each time.

Put refuse containers where they can be easily seen, on the edge of your property (without obstructing the pavement or road) by 7am on collection days and no earlier than the night before.
